

## DR. EVELYN G. SMITH

ADVISOR TO THE PRESIDENT;  
ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

Dr. Evelyn G. Smith has been employed at LMU since August 1998. She became Advisor to the President in July 2019. Dr. Smith provides direct support to the President on executive matters, represents the President with internal and external constituencies, and manages special programs/projects. She also has oversight of Global Studies and the Abraham Lincoln Library and Museum. She is also an assistant professor of computer science.

During her tenure at LMU, Dr. Smith has held several positions, including Director of Foundation Research, Assistant Professor of Computer Information Systems, Interim Chair of the Department of Business, Dean of Academic Services, Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs, Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, and Special Assistant to the President for Executive Affairs.

Other areas for which Dr. Smith has had oversight include the Registrar's Office, International Programs, Extended Site Services, the Carnegie-Vincent Library, the Center for Teaching and Learning Excellence (CTLE), and daily operations of the Office of Academic Affairs. Dr. Smith's prior experience includes 12 years at IBM in Boca Raton, Florida; and 12 years at The Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Laboratory in Laurel, Maryland.

Dr. Smith earned a Bachelor of Science (1994) and Master of Science (2002) in Computer Science from Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale, Florida; and a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership from East Tennessee State University (2014).

Dr. Smith is a member of the President's Cabinet and the Kincaid Oversight Committee; she serves as an ex officio member of Academic Council and LMU's Lincoln Institute for the Study of Leadership and Public Policy; and a charter member of the Teaching and Learning with Technology Roundtable. She is a member of the LMU Women of Service, Thomas Walker Civic Club, and Christ Episcopal Church (Big Stone Gap, Va.). She resides in Rose Hill, Va., with her husband Ron. They have one son and four grandchildren.
